Messorio, which was born in 1994, is our personal interpretation of one of the grape varieties most commonly grown in the Bolgheri area: Merlot.

The name Messorio refers to the ancient Tuscan practice of wheat harvesting, the most important time of the year in our countryside: once it meant wheat, now, to us, it is all about grape harvesting.

A generous grape variety, perfect for the typical Bolgherese wine blends, but tricky and difficult when made into a single varietal wine.

Currently considered to be one of Italy's most representative Merlot-based wines, Messorio is very complex and elegant and evolves beautifully in the bottle year by year.

First Vintage: 1994

Grape varieties: 100% Merlot

Vineyards: Vignone 1999

Training system: Guyot

Yield: 800 gr per plant

Harvest: 2nd week of September

Winemaking: Fermentation and maceration for 20 days, a part in steel tanks and a part in concrete

Aging: 18 months in new oak barriques

Bottling: July 5, 2016

Total Production: 8.796 Bottles, 250 Magnums, 50 Double Magnums
